

ADA Compliance Inspections

The Department of Justice revised the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) regulations requiring that those elements in existing facilities for which there are neither technical nor scoping specifications in the 1991 Standards, must be modified to the extent readily achievable to comply with the 2010 Standards. Elements that must be reviewed include:

- Residential facilities and dwelling units
- Amusement rides
- Recreational boating facilities
- Exercise machines and equipment
- Fishing piers and platforms
- Golf facilities
- Miniature golf facilities
- Play areas
- Saunas and steam rooms
- Swimming pools, wading pools, and spas
- Shooting facilities with firing positions
- Miscellaneous:
 - Team or player seating
 - Accessible route to bowling lanes
 - Accessible route in court sports facilities
